only child	独生子女	Being an only child can be lonely sometimes.
generation gap	代沟	There's often a generation gap between parents and children.
get along with	相处融洽	I get along well with my classmates.
fall out with	闹矛盾	I fell out with my friend over a misunderstanding.
make up with	和好	We made up after a week.
keep in touch	保持联系	I still keep in touch with my best friend from school.
